

SAINT JOSE SANCHEZ DEL RIO - "MY FAITH IS NOT FOR SALE"

During the 1924-1928 religious persecution by Mexican President Plutarco Elias Calles, St. Jose became a Mexican-Cristero, fighting against the anti-Catholic legislation that sought the abolishment of the Catholic faith by whatever means necessary. The onslaught against Catholics was brutal, with some 50,000 deaths. In self-defence, Catholics took up



arms to defend their faith. Whenever they charged into battle, the Cristeros, as they were called, shouted: "Viva Cristo Rey!" "Long live Christ the King!".

During this period, many Catholics were martyred, including Jose Luis Sanchez del Rio. From a young age he had a great love and enthusiasm for the Blessed Sacrament, and encouraged his friends to have more devotion to Our Lord and Our Lady of Guadalupe. Jose longed to defend his faith and his country. He pleaded with the Cristero General Mendoza to let him join the movement, which he eventually did.

In a certain battle, Jose was captured by the federalists and locked up in a church sacristy that had been turned into a prison. There he was severely tortured. Despite all attempts to get the young Jose to denounce Jesus Christ, and live, he refused, exclaiming: "my faith is not for sale".

On the way to execution, soldiers struck him savagely with sharp machetes. This made Jose cry all the louder, "Viva Cristo Rey!". Jose's torturers cut off the soles of his feet and forced him to walk on salt to his grave. The boy screamed with pain but would not give in. The soldiers said: "If you shout, 'Death to Christ the King', we will spare your life." His reply was defiant: "Long live Christ the King! Long live Our Lady of Guadalupe!" Stabbed relentlessly and eventually shot on the 10th February 1928, Jose entered eternal life. He was Beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on the 20th November 2005 and was canonised by Pope Francis last Sunday 16th October, and declared a Saint. This young boy is an inspiration to us all.
