

#### **THE JUBILEE OF 2025**

The Pope has called a Jubilee Year for 2025. It will be opened in Rome by Pope Francis on Christmas Eve at St. Peter's Basilica, and in each Cathedral Church of the world on Sunday 29th December. A Jubilee Year is marked every 25 years to commemorate the Lord's Incarnation and therefore the beginnings of our salvation. A Jubilee Year places particular emphasis on mercy, conversion and pilgrimage. The principal symbol of the Jubilee Year is the Holy Door. This is one of the doors leading into St. Peter's Basilica. Between one Jubilee and another, it is not only closed but actually bricked up. These bricks are removed this year and Pope Francis will be the first pilgrim to cross the threshold of the Holy Door on Christmas Eve. Holy Doors are also opened in the other principal basilicas of the City: St. Paul's Outside the Walls [the burial place of the Apostle Paul], St. John Lateran's [the Pope's Cathedral], and St. Mary Major's [the oldest church in the West dedicated to Our Lady – and where our own Monsignor Eamonn McLaughlin is a Canon].

What is significant about the Holy Door? It is simply a symbol of Christ, the Gate of the Sheepfold. As the door of a church signifies entering into the dwelling place of God, the place where the local Church gathers to worship God, it reminds us of our baptism, the door to salvation, the entry into the life of the Church and the beginnings of eternal life within the soul. For those who go on pilgrimage to Rome, crossing the threshold of the Holy Door becomes a powerful symbolic moment of the journey of life and of faith. Of course, it is through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Holy Eucharist and dedication to faith and the deepening of our faith that brings real conversion and fruit from the Jubilee Year. This can be done as effectively at home by marking the Jubilee Year as a year when we commit ourselves to a pilgrimage of faith from one week to another, with a focus on certain major moments, including Cathedral events and pilgrimage to our own holy places. For those who are able to travel, there will be a parish pilgrimage to Rome for the Jubilee Year. Dates will be confirmed in the New Year. On Sunday 29th December at 12 noon Mass, we will celebrate the diocesan opening of the Jubilee Year in union with all the Cathedrals of the world.
