

FROM THE BISHOPS' STATEMENT FOR ELECTION 2024

The Bishops have issued a statement outlining some of the priorities they see for the incoming government. Firstly, they emphasise that voting is an important participation in the democratic process, even if one cannot find a candidate or party to reflect one's views. Catholics might also consider the following in engaging with candidates and deciding how to vote:

Living with dignity. Too many people in Ireland are still suffering financial hardships due to increased costs of food and energy. The continuing increase in the levels of homelessness is a scandal. All families, regardless of income level, should be able to access housing that is adequate to their needs.

Welcoming those who come to us in their need. Our political leaders should strive to alleviate the key shortcomings in our economy and social fabric so that all those who come to Ireland to seek a better life and contribute to our society will be welcome and know that they belong.

Valuing every life in every condition. Since the introduction of the legislation in 2018, 40,000 abortions have been carried out in Ireland. Some politicians want to make it even more liberal. The outgoing Dáil has accepted a recent report from an Oireachtas Committee that assisted dying should be allowed. We totally reject that recommendation because a fundamental principle of civilised society is that no person can lawfully take the life of another.

Caring for our common home. We all have a responsibility to protect the future of our planet, our common home.

Work so that peace may reign in our hearts and our world. The war in Gaza and the Middle East must stop now. Enough is enough! Similarly, the international community has a role to play in bringing peace to Ukraine and to other areas of conflict in our world, including Sudan, Myanmar and Yemen. We ask all political parties to ensure the budget for overseas development aid is maintained and increased over the coming mandate.

Church-State structured dialogue is not functioning and in need of review. Churches and faith communities have an important contribution to bring to the national and local conversation by helping build and sustain an Ireland that protects and values the potential of every person. The current structures for Church-State dialogue are not functioning for the greater good of society and are in need of review.
